Pursuant to Article I, section 24 of the Florida Constitution, and chapter 119, F.S., I am requesting an opportunity to inspect or obtain any and all copies of public records that were transcribed from a hearing held by the Supreme Court of Florida regarding the matter of the Florida Bar v. Mark Stopa, 147 So.3d 530 (2014), (Florida Bar File No. 2012-11,175 (12B) and 2013-10,440 (12B))

I am specifically requesting either in hard copy or electronic file format, a legible and un-redacted copy of the transcript of Mr. Stopa's hearing, which was publicly recorded. I request a waiver of all fees for this request since the disclosure of the information I seek is requested by WKDW 97.5 FM as a licensed public broadcaster and it is in the public interest making the disclosure a matter of public interest. In the interest of the efficiency of this request, I would prefer an electronic copy of the transcription or the audio recorded file if it is available.

Should you deny my request, or any part of the request, please state in writing the basis for the denial, including the exact statutory citation authorizing the denial as required by s. 119.07(1)(d), F.S.A.
